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## LOCAL AREA WALKS

During the year there may be occasions when students will be involved in learning opportunities within our local community. Examples may include visits to the Wharf Street local shops, the sporting field adjacent to the school, walks around the local area and visits / performances at local churches, fire station, nursing homes and local pre-schools.

Children are sometimes required to cross Lake Street but more often children are required to cross Head Street to participate in educational activities in the extended outdoor learning area (opposite school). This area is the ocean front reserve bounded by the foot of 2nd Head in the west and the foot of Bennett's Head in the east. At no stage will students be allowed access to the water.
